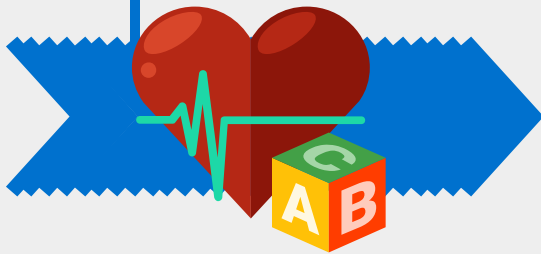


2019

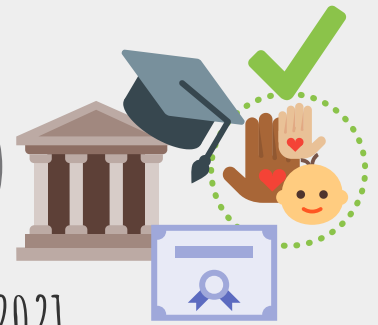
JANUARY 2021

The exploratory board worked throughout 2021 to create the vision, mission, values, and goals of the Georgia Association for Infant Mental Health: Birth to Five (GA-AIMH).



FALL 2021

The exploratory board released a request for proposals to public universities in the state to determine a home for GA-AIMH. Georgia State University's Mark Chaffin Center for Healthy Development (MCCHD) was selected.
